1. This Court is informed that the suit has been settled between the parties.
2. The Consent terms are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.
3. The Consent terms are executed by the authorized signatory of the Plaintiff and by Defendant No. 1 who is proprietor of Defendant No. 2. The Defendant No. 1 is present virtually and reiterates the terms

of the Consent Terms. He submits to a decree on admission in terms of prayer clauses (a), (b) and (d) of the Plaint. His identity is verified from his Aadhar Card and by his counsel. The Suit is decreed on admission in terms of prayer clause (a), (b) and (d) of the Plaint.
