1. This Court is informed that the dispute has been amicably settled between the parties.
2. The Consent Terms are tendered which are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. The Consent Terms are signed by the

authorized signatory of Plaintiff No. 1, Plaintiff No. 2 and Plaintiff No. 3 and by the authorized signatory of Defendant No. 1 and constituted attorney of Defendant No. 2.

3. The constituted attorney of Defendant Nos. 1 and 2 is present in Court and reiterates the terms of the Consent Terms. He submits to a decree on admission in terms of prayer clauses (a) to (g) of the plaint. His identity is verified by his counsel and from his aadhar card which is placed on record. The statements made in the Consent Terms are accepted as undertaking given to this Court.

4. The suit is decreed in terms of prayer clauses (a) to (g) of the Plaint.

5. Refund of Court-fees as per rules.
