1. Heard Mr Mishra, learned Advocate for Petitioner.
2. Present Judge's Order has been allowed on 27.01.2026.
Unfortunately the same has not been complied with till today as the
said order is not specifying or directing to break open the locker in
respect of which the same is passed.
