1. This Court is informed that the Suit has been settled between the parties. The consent terms are tendered which are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. The consent terms are signed by the constituted attorney for the Plaintiff and by the Defendant and also countersigned by the respective counsel. The Defendant is present in person in Court and reiterates the terms of the consent terms. He
