Commercial IP Suit No. 716 of 2025 :

1. This Court is informed that the dispute has been settled between the parties.
2. The Consent Terms are tendered which are taken on record and marked "X" for identification. The Consent Terms are signed by the constituted attorney of the Plaintiff and by Director of Defendant. The Director of the Defendant is present personally and reiterates the terms of the Consent Terms. He submits to decree on admission in

terms of prayer clauses (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) of the plaint. The statements made in the Consent Terms are accepted as undertaking given to this Court. The Board Resolutions are annexed to the Consent Terms.
