- PC :** 1. Perused Petition. Heard Ld. Advocate for petitioner. This petition is for Probate of last Will and Testament of deceased filed by petitioner namely Sunil Jethalal Shah being one of the Executors named under the Will of deceased. The deceased namely Krishna Sunil Shah died at Mumbai on 22.08.2025. Copy of death certificate is annexed to the petition. Identification proof of deceased viz. copy of Aadhaar Card is annexed to the petition.
2. The deceased left behind her last Will and Testament which was duly executed at Mumbai on 03.01.2024. The said Will is in English language. The Para No.2 of the Will refers to the appointment of Executors. Only three Executors appointed under the Will. Petitioner is one of the executors and other two executors namely Keval Shah and Nirav Shah have renounced their rights to act as an Executors and Affidavit dated 15.11.2025 is filed to that effect. Residuary clause in respect of properties of deceased is mentioned at para No. 8 of the Will.
3. Ld. Advocate for petitioner submits that parents of deceased predeceased the deceased. Deceased was survived by her husband and two sons. Out of them husband is petitioner herein and both the sons have given their consents in favour of the petitioner herein. Consent Affidavits are on record. There are no other legal heirs.
4. Petitioner's oath is filed. Affidavit of Nirav Shah dated 15.11.2025 one of the Attesting Witness to the Will is filed. Affidavit of Service of General Citation dated 03.01.2026 is filed. Delay is explained and the same is condoned. All other legal formalities are complied with. Hence, petition is granted.
5. Office to issue Probate as prayed after verifying whether any cross petition is filed or whether any caveat is filed.
