3. For the reasons mentioned in the affidavit in support the Applicant is permitted to publish the citation in "Gujarat Samachar"

in stead of “Jam-e-Jamshed” in vernacular language i.e. Gujarati language.

4. Applicant to publish the citation in two newspapers viz. “Free Press Journal” in English language and “Gujarat Samachar” in vernacular language i.e. Gujarati, widely circulated in Mumbai by way of substituted service upon ALL CONCERNED legal heirs of the deceased.

5. Applicant to file the affidavit of publication once the citation is published within two weeks thereafter.
