) Advocate for the applicant submits that for the
) same reason, delay of 14 days caused in filing
) present Chamber Order, which was not
) intentional. Hence, it is prayed that present
) Chamber Order may be allowed as prayed by

) Contentions raised in Affidavit, remain
) uncontested for want of resistance on the part
) of respondents. Moreover, substantial justice
) cannot be denied on technical ground. I am of
) the opinion that applicant should get one

) merits. However, it would be just and proper
) to impose certain cost on the applicant so that
