1. This Court is informed that the dispute has been amicably settled between the parties.
2. The Consent Terms are tendered which are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. The Consent Terms are signed by constituted attorney of Plaintiff and by proprietor of Defendant No. 1, Defendant No. 2 and Defendant No. 3. The proprietor of Defendant

No. 1 is a proprietor of Defendant No. 2. The proprietors of Defendants are present virtually and reiterates the terms of the Consent Terms. They submit to decree on admission in terms of prayer clauses (a), (b) and (c) of the Plaint.

3. The suit is decreed in terms of prayer clauses (a), (b) and (c) of the Plaint.

4. The statements made in the Consent Terms are accepted as undertaking given to this Court.

5. Refund of Court-fees as per Rules.

6. Court Receiver's Report is disposed of. Court Receiver stands discharged without passing of accounts. All costs, charges and expenses of the Court Receiver to be paid by the Plaintiff within period of eight days on demand being raised by Court Receiver.
