Ms.Jenny Somaiya, learned Counsel, appears for the Applicant and submits that since the service of the disclosure order has been refused and since the same is a good service and is to be treated as duly served, this Court may direct issuance of bailable warrant against the Respondents no.1, 2 and 3.

2. Having heard the learned Counsel and having considered the submissions, this Court deems it appropriate to issue bailable warrants in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each against the Respondents no.1, 2 and 3, returnable on 8th April 2026.

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3. The Applicant to assist the Registry and furnish details of the concerned Police station for the execution of the bailable warrants. The Senior Police Inspector of the concerned Police station to have the said bailable warrants executed and secure the presence of the Respondents no.1, 2 and 3 on the next date.
