By this Chamber Order the Applicant seeks permission to serve the citation upon ALL CONCERNED of the deceased by way of substituted service as per schedule annexed to the Chamber Order.

2. Perused the schedule. The Applicant applies for publication of citation in two newspapers viz. "Free Press Journal" in English Language and in "Janmbhoomi" in vernacular language i.e. Gujarati, widely circulated in Mumbai.

3. Perused the affidavit in support. The Applicant has stated in the affidavit that, she has made an averment in the Petition Para 8 and 9 regarding the legal heirs of the deceased. The Applicant, therefore, requested to permit him to publish the citation in two newspapers viz. "Free Press Journal" in English Language and in "Janmbhoomi" in vernacular language i.e. Gujarati, widely circulated in Mumbai.

4. Heard. Ld. Advocate for the Applicant submits that, the deceased died as issueless and parents of the deceased husband predeceased her. He further submits that, the deceased left behind no brother-in-law and sister-in-law and deceased left no surviving

legal heirs from her husband's side as contemplated Section 15 of the Hindu Succession Act. He further submits that, after the death of the husband of the deceased, the deceased was residing alongwith her family since the year 1992 till her death and she had taken care of the deceased no one came to meet her even her last rites and rituals by the Applicant. She, further, submits that, the Applicant is not aware of the any other surviving legal heirs of the deceased. He, therefore, prays that, the Chamber Order be allowed.

5. Perused para 8-9 of the Petition. For the reasons mentioned in the affidavit in support the Chamber Order is allowed. Applicant to publish the citation in two newspapers viz. "Free Press Journal" in English Language and in "Janmbhoomi" in vernacular language i.e. Gujarati, widely circulated in Mumbai, by way of substituted service of citation upon ALL CONCERNED of the deceased within four weeks from the date of uploading this Order. Applicant to file the affidavit of publication once the citation is published within two weeks thereafter.

6. Registry is directed to issue fresh citation, if required.
