) Advocate submits that there is delay of 3 days
) in filing Chamber Order, which was not
) intentional. Id. Advocate made a statement
) that as on date, captioned Petition is
) uncontested. Statement is accepted.
) Accordingly, it is submitted that captioned
) Petition may be restored to file by condoning
) delay.

) Considering grounds in the Affidavit, I am of
) the view that the applicant should get one
) opportunity to pursue with captioned Petition.
) So also, substantial justice cannot be denied
) on technical ground. Hence, I consider
) present Chamber Order favourably. In view
) thereof, Chamber Order is granted as prayed.

) numbered by filing/ uploading compliance
) praecipe within a week from the date of
) uploading of order, failing Petition to stand
) rejected for non-compliance of office
