1. The present Interim Application seeks amendment to the cause title of the plaint and deletion of the name of Plaintiff No. 7 in the Suit, in Notice of Motion No. 10 of 2017, and in Interim Application (L) No. 15266 of 2022 taken out in the Suit, since Plaintiff No. 7 has passed away on 26th November 2025. There is no opposition to this Interim Application and accordingly, the same is allowed in terms of prayer Clause – (a) and the following order is passed:

:: ORDER::

i) The Plaintiffs are permitted to amend the plaint,

Notice of Motion No. 10 of 2017 and Interim Application (L) No. 15266 of 2022 in terms of the proposed amendment set out in the schedule annexed to the Interim Application. This amendment shall be carried out, on or before 10th February 2026.

(ii) Re-verification is dispensed with.

(iii) Interim Application is disposed of in terms of the above order.

(iv) There shall be no order as to costs.

2. Pursuant to the last order, the Plaintiff tenders an Affidavit-of-Service dated 2nd February 2026. The same is taken on record.
