1. Heard learned Advocate for the applicants.
2. This is an application for condonation of delay in filing the application for restoration of first appeal, of which registration was refused for failure to remove the office objections.
3. Learned Advocate for the applicants submits that the delay of 63 days occurred since the applicants were not aware about the order of refusal of registration, and therefore, the delay is unintentional.
4. Having regard to the contents of the application and submissions advanced, the application is allowed and the delay of 63 days in filing the application for restoration of first appeal is condoned, however, subject to costs of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two

Thousand Five Hundred Only), to be paid by the applicants to the High Court Bar Association Library, Nagpur, within a period of two weeks from today.

5. The civil application is accordingly disposed of.

MISC. CIVIL APPLICATION (STAMP) NO.12697 OF 2023

6. This is an application for restoration of first appeal, of which registration was refused by order dated 11.04.2023, for non removal of the office objections within stipulated period.

7. Learned Advocate for the applicants submits that the applicants wants to contest the first appeal on merits and therefore, they seek restoration of first appeal.

8. Considering the reasons mentioned in the application and submissions advanced, the application for restoration of first appeal is allowed. The order dated 11.04.2023, passed by the Registrar (Judicial), is quashed and set-aside. The applicants are directed to remove the office objections within a period of two weeks from today. On removal of the office objections, the first appeal be restored.

9. In view of the above, the miscellaneous civil application is disposed of.
