1. This is an application for condonation of delay of 142 days in filing the statutory appeal.
2. In response to the notice on this application, Advocate Mr. A.P. Deshmukh, appears and waives for respondent No.1.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the delay occurred on account of seeking necessary permissions and approvals in filing the statutory appeal.
4. Having regard to the contents of the application and submissions advanced, the delay of 142 days does not appear to be intentional and the application needs to be allowed in the interest of justice.
