- 1) This is an application seeking transfer of Marriage Petition No.147/2025 from the file of the learned 8th Joint Civil Judge Senior Division, Akola to learned Civil Judge Senior Division, Darwha.
- 2) The applicant-wife is residing at village Karajgaon, situated approximately 15 to 20 k.m. away from Darwha. Darwha is situated at a distance of approximately 110 k.m. from Akola. It is stated in the application that, in order to reach Akola, the wife would be required to first travel to Darwha and thereafter take a bus connection to Akola. The applicant-wife has also filed a proceeding under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, which is registered as PWDVA Application No.19/2025.
- 3) In view of the aforesaid although the respondent-husband opposes the application, the transfer application is allowed in the following terms :-

(1) Hindu Marriage Petition No.147/2025 is directed to be transferred from the learned 8th Joint Civil Judge Senior Division, Akola to the learned Civil Judge Senior Division, Darwaha.

(2) In the event the respondent-husband makes an application for appearance through video-conferencing, the same may be considered favourably and permission to appear through video-conferencing may be granted on such dates and at such stages as is deemed appropriate by the learned Civil Judge Senior Division, Darwaha.
