1. The present application is filed seeking transfer of following proceedings from Bhandara to Nagpur.

(i) Marriage Petition No.150 of 2023,

(ii) Misc. Criminal Application No.161 of 2022,

(iii) PWDVA Application No.28 of 2020.

2. It is informed that the divorce petition (MP No.150 of 2023) is pending at the stage of evidence. Likewise, PWDVA Application No.28 of 2020 was pending for evidence before the proceedings were ordered to be stayed vide order dated 24.12.2025 passed in the present application. Misc. Criminal Application No.161 of 2022 is for enforcement of maintenance order.

3. It is stated in the application that the applicant/wife is suffering from back pain and is need of regular physio therapy. She has stated that she has advised against long distance travel. It appears from the statement in the application that the alleged ailment is not serious. It

must be stated that the distance between Bhandara to Nagpur is 65 kms.

4. Having regard to the stage at which the proceedings are pending as also the distance between the two places, in my considered opinion, case of ordering transfer is not made out. Transfer application is **rejected**.

5. In the event the applicant/wife makes an application for appearance through Video Conferencing, the same may be considered favourably and permission to appear through Video Conferencing may be granted on such dates and at such stages as is deemed appropriate by the learned Family Court.
