1. Heard.
2. Leave is granted to correct the cause title. Correction be carried out forthwith.
3. By the present petition, the petitioner has approached this Court seeking a declaration that she is entitled to the benefits of the old pension scheme and a further direction to the respondents to close the DCPS account and extend to her the benefits of the old pension scheme.
4. After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and upon perusal of the petition, we notice that at page 59, there is a proposal submitted by respondent No.5-Management, which runs respondent No.6-School where the petitioner is serving, addressed to respondent No.4-District Social Welfare Officer, Zilla Parishad,

Buldhana, seeking grant of the aforesaid relief to the petitioner and application of the old pension scheme on the ground that the advertisement was issued prior to 01.11.2005.

5. The learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the aforesaid proposal which was submitted on 21.10.2024 has not yet been decided by the respondent No.4.

6. In view of the above, we **dispose of** the present petition with direction to the respondent No.4 to decide the proposal dated 21.10.2024 within eight weeks from the date of the receipt of this order.

7. The learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to furnish copy of this order to the concerned respondent within two weeks from today.

8. The decision taken shall be communicated to the petitioner, so also the respondent Nos.5 and 6, within two weeks from the date of such decision.

Accordingly, the writ petition is **disposed of** in the above terms. No order as to costs.
