(2) The grievance of the Petitioner is that though he has made representation to the Respondent No. 3 – Management and Respondent No. 4 – School requesting to grant benefit of Graduate Teacher in view of increase of quota of Graduate Teacher from 25% to 33%, however, the Management rejected the said representation of the Petitioner without granting any opportunity of hearing.

(3) It reveals that there is no prayer against the State Authorities and only against the Management.

(4) In view thereof, we are of the considered opinion that the Petition is not maintainable. However, liberty is granted to the

Petitioner to file representation before the Competent Authority. If such representation is filed, the Competent Authority shall decide the same within a period of eight weeks from the date of filing of the representation.

(5) With the above observation, the Writ Petition stands **disposed of**. Pending Application(s), if any, stand(s) **disposed of**.
