1. Heard.
2. In view of the reply filed by respondent No. 3, particularly the statements made in paragraphs 5 to 9, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing survives in the present petition and that the purpose stands served. However, he requests that a time frame be fixed within which the respondent–University shall complete the promotion process.
3. In response, the learned counsel for the respondent–University submits that the process can be completed within a period of four months.
4. Accordingly, we direct the respondent–University to complete process of promotion within a period of five months from today.
5. The learned counsel for the respondent–University

undertakes to communicate a copy of this order to the concerned authorities of the University within a period of one week from today.

6. If the petitioner makes a representation seeking grant of deemed date of promotion, the University may consider the same in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the petition is **disposed** of in the above terms. No order as to costs.
