1. Heard.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioners, upon instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition. However, he submits that some time will be required to approach the Competent Court/Authority by filing necessary proceedings, as permissible under law. He therefore prays that the interim relief granted by this Court vide order dated 24.12.2025, may be continued for a limited period.
3. Permission is granted.
4. Accordingly, the writ petition is **disposed of** as withdrawn with liberty to file appropriate proceedings before the Competent Court/Authority, as permissible under law.
5. The status quo granted by this Court, vide order

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dated 24.12.2025, i.e., not to take any coercive action, shall continue for a period of four weeks from today. Upon expiry of the said period of four weeks, the interim protection shall stand automatically vacated.
