1. Heard learned Advocate for the applicant.
2. This is an application filed by the original claimant, seeking condonation of delay of 3381 days in filing statutory appeal.
3. Learned Advocate for the applicant, on instructions, states that the applicant is ready to waive the statutory benefits and interest for the period of delay. It is also submitted that the controversy involved in the appeal is covered by the judgments delivered by this Court in other identical matters.
