The civil application is filed under Order V Rule 20 of the C.P.C., 1908 for substituted service upon Respondent No.6 by way of paper publication. It is stated in the application that the Respondent No.6 could not be served for want of correct address. Further, it is stated in the application that the Respondent No.6 is trying to avoid service of notice issued by this Hon'ble Court. Thus, the applicant wants to serve Respondent No.6 by way of paper publication.

Hence, considering the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. As per office note, appellant has not filed application for correct address of Respondent Nos. 8 & 9 as notice issued to aforesaid respondents received back unserved. Hence, two weeks time is granted to the appellant to file civil application for correct address of Respondent Nos. 8 & 9.
