. The respondent, though served, none appeared on his behalf.

2. The petitioner/wife has filed present application seeking transfer of Hindu Marriage Petition (HMP) No.83 of 2025 from the file of the learned Family Court, Akola to the file of learned Family Court at Yavatmal.

3. The applicant/wife is staying with her 4 year old daughter at Yavatmal. Distance between Yavatmal and Akola is around 175 Kilometers. Apart from this, she has initiated proceedings bearing Petition No.E-122/2025 and MCA No.90 of 2025, against the husband which are pending at Yavatmal.

4. In view of the aforesaid, it will be expedient that divorce petition bearing HMP No.83 of 2025 is transferred from the file of the learned Family Court, Akola to the file of learned Family Court at Yavatmal. Misc. Civil Application is therefore **allowed**, directing

transfer of HMP No.83 of 2025 from Family Court, Akola to Family Court at Yavatmal.

5. In the event the respondent/husband makes an application for appearance through video-conferencing, the same may be considered favorably and permission to appear through video-conferencing may be granted on such dates and at such stages as is deemed appropriate by the learned Family Court.
