2. The applicant seeks review of the order dated 04/02/2026 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.323/2026.

3. The perusal of the order reveals that basically the petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 27/01/2026 passed by the respondent No.2-Collector, Gondia. In earlier round of litigation, the aforesaid order was placed on record by the learned Assistant Government Pleader along with pursis dated 04/02/2026.
