1. Nobody appears for the petitioners.
2. On 23.03.2026, recording repeated absence of the petitioners, this Court has passed the following order.

“1. Nobody appears on behalf of petitioners.

2. On 13th February, 2026, the following order was passed :-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioners again seeks time to deposit 50% of the amount, which is the outstanding amount, as was directed by this Court by an order dated 16.01.2026. The time to deposit the amount was extended on the request of the petitioners by order dated 05.02.2026 and one week time was granted. It was also ordered by order dated 05.02.2026 that on failure of the petitioners in depositing the amount within the time granted, the petition be listed for vacating interim relief.

2. Till today, the amount is not deposited and the learned counsel for petitioners is again seeking 15 days time.

3. Considering the fact that the sufficient time was already granted and subject to deposit of the amount, the interim relief was granted, the interim relief granted on 16.01.2026 stands vacated.”

3. *Today nobody appears on behalf of petitioners. It appears that petitioners are not interested to prosecute the petition.*

4. *In view of above, list the petition under the caption "For dismissal" on 02.04.2026."*

3. Today also, nobody appears on behalf of the petitioners. Thus, it is clear that the petitioners are not interested in prosecuting the instant petition. Hence, the writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
