According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions issued in the aforesaid communication have not been complied with.

4. In view of communication dated 23/12/2025, we direct respondent No.5-District Special Auditor, Class-I, Co-operative

Societies, Amravati to act in accordance with the same within a period of six weeks from today.

5. The petitioner undertakes to produce copy of this order before the Authorities within a period of one week from today.

6. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
