The civil application is filed by appellant under Order V Rule 20 of the C.P.C., 1908 for substituted service upon Respondent No.3 by way of paper publication. It is stated in the application that the notice issued to respondent No.3 received back unserved for want of correct address. It is further stated in the application that appellant made three to four attempts to serve respondent No.3, however, respondent No.3 is avoiding the service of notice. Thus, the appellant wants to serve respondent No.3 by way of paper publication.

Hence, considering the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Substituted service be effected upon **aforesaid respondent** by publishing a notice in widely circulated local daily newspaper “**Dainik Bhaskar (Marathi)**” in terms of **Order V Rule 20 (1-A) of C.P.C.**, returnable within five weeks from the date of publication of notice.
