4. Heard Ms. Anita Mategaonkar, learned
counsel appearing for the appellant- Insurance Company,
Shri P. R. Agrawal, learned counsel appearing for
respondent nos. 1 to 4/original claimants at length.

By the present application, respondent nos. 1 to 4/claimants seek permission to withdraw the entire amount of compensation under the judgment and award dated 01.01.2025 passed in MACP No. 366/2018 by the Member, Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Amravati deposited before this Court in pursuance of the order dated 14.10.2025 passed by this Court in Civil Application No. 3731/2025.

6. The application is strongly opposed by the learned counsel appearing for the appellant.

Considering the reasons mentioned in the application, I am inclined to grant the present application and permit respondent nos. 1 to 4/claimants to withdraw 50% of the compensation amount along with accrued interest thereto as per the apportionment given by the Tribunal on furnishing usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
