The civil application is filed by appellant under Order V Rule 20 of the C.P.C., 1908 for substituted service upon Respondent No.1 by way of paper publication. Notice issued respondent No.1 received back unserved with bailiff report that house of respondent no.1 is locked. It is further contended that further notices were issued to respondent No.1 by speed post, regular mode and also to the address of daughter of respondent No.1, however failed. Thus, the appellant wants to serve respondent No.1 by way of paper publication.
