1. *Ms. Roma Bondade, learned counsel appearing for Mr. Bute, learned counsel, has marked her appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3.*
2. *By order dated 14.01.2026, this Court observed inaction on the part of respondent No.3 in not lodging the FIR, despite the issue being covered by the judgment of this Court in the case of Dr. Jayant Vasantanrao Awchar vs. State of Maharashtra and others. Respondent No.3 is, therefore, directed to file an affidavit explaining the inaction on his part.*

4. The petitioner is satisfied with the development.
