In response to previous order, learned A.P.P. submits that respondent No.3 is monitoring the investigation and, in fact, has constituted a Special Investigating Team to trace the petitioner's son. 3. We direct respondent No.3 to apprise the development in the investigation fortnightly to the petitioner.

4. With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
