4. Learned counsel submits that she was appointed to represent the appellant on 02.12.2025. It is further submitted that when the matter was listed on 12.01.2026, her name did not reflect in the cause list and, therefore, her absence on the said date was neither deliberate nor intentional. She has also tendered an unconditional apology.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has no objection if the application is allowed.

6. In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 12.01.2026 stands recalled. Learned appointed counsel is directed to make every endeavour to represent the appellant on each and every date hereafter without fail.

7. Consequently, the newly appointed counsel stands discharged.

8. The criminal application stands disposed of accordingly.
