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5. Heard learned counsel appearing for the applicant and learned APP for the respondent-prosecution.

6. Since the grievance of the applicant is in respect of shabby / faint pages, there is no need to call the say of the non-applicant No.2.

7. Since the learned counsel appearing for the applicant undertakes that he will not rely and refer the faint pages during the course of the argument, it would be just and proper to overrule the objection and filing of shabby / faint pages is dispensed with.

8. Accordingly, criminal application stands disposed of.
