1. Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant.
2. Issue notice to the non-applicants, returnable on 07.05.2026.
3. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of non-applicant no.1/State.
4. The applicant are apprehending arrest in connection with crime No. 167/2026 with Police Station, Shegaon City, Dist. Buldhana for the offences punishable under Sections 75, 78, 333, 351(2), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 ; Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 ; and Sections 3(1)(w)(i), &(ii) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.
5. The contention is that there was a love affair between non-applicant no.2 and the son of the applicants, which was not approved by the parents of non-applicant/victim. The further contention is that the applicants had been to the house of the complainant to have a talk over

the love affair between their son and the victim. A false FIR has been lodged against the applicants alleging that they abused and threatened her parents.

7. Considering the submissions and the nature of allegations in the FIR against the applicants, a case is made out for grant of ad-interim protection to the applicants. Hence, the following Order :

i) Pending the application, in the event of arrest of applicants – (1) Hemlata Sanjay Bobade ; and (2) Sanjay Ramnath Bobade in connection with crime No. 167/2026 with Police Station, Shegaon City, Dist. Buldhana for the offences punishable under Sections 75, 78, 333, 351(2), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 ; Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 ; and Sections 3(1)(w)(i), &(ii) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, they be released on bail on furnishing a PR bond of Rs.25,000/- each with one solvent surety each in the like amount.

ii) The applicants shall attend the concerned police station on every Thursday between 10.00 am and 12.00 noon for a period of three weeks and shall co-operate in the investigation.

iii) The applicants shall not indulge in tampering with the prosecution evidence or threaten the prosecution witnesses in any manner.
