ORDER

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Para No.7(b) that “the petitioner shall stay at Vellore and report before the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Vellore daily at 10.30 a.m., apart from the hearing dates before the Trial Court concerned, until further orders. It is made clear that the

petitioner shall not enter into the area where the victim girl is residing” in Crl.O.P.No.28517 of 2025 dated 13.11.2025.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the petitioner has been regularly complying with the conditions imposed by this Court and that final report has been filed.

3. Considering the said submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.28517 of 2025 dated 17.10.2025, is **relaxed** and that the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police **as and when required for interrogation**.

4. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition stands ordered.
