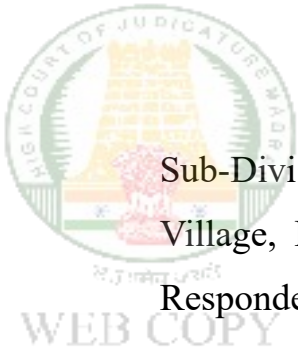

ORDER

WMP. No.1568 of 2026 is ordered subject to the payment of separate court fee.

2.This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the second respondent to survey and demarcate the property, which according to the petitioners is owned by them, based on their representation dated 16.12.2025, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

3. The petitioners had submitted their representation dated 16.12.2025 for the aforesaid purpose. Since the same has not been considered till date, the petitioners have filed this writ petition.



4. Mr.R.P.Murugan Raja, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1, 2 and 4. Mr.R.Venkatesa Perumal, learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) accepts notice on behalf of the third respondent.

5. No prejudice will be caused to the second respondent if the said authority is directed to survey and demarcate the boundaries of the petitioners' property morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, after hearing the objections if any from the neighbouring land owners as well as any other party whom the second respondent deems it fit to enquire. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of in the following manner:-

(a) Before surveying the lands in question, the second respondent is directed to issue notice to the neighbouring land owners and also to any other party, whom the second respondent deems it fit to put on notice.

(b) After receiving objections if any and after considering the same, the fourth respondent shall conduct survey and demarcate the boundaries of the property morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



(c) If the need arises for police assistance and on a request made by the second respondent, the third respondent shall render police assistance for the effective implementation of this order.
