3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents submitted that the petitioner has sent the representation very recently, i.e., 30.12.2025. He further submitted that the first respondent will consider the same and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks.

4. Recording the aforesaid submission, the first respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 30.12.2025 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
