Prayer in W.P.No.1659 of 2026:

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest on the belated payment of terminal benefits such as Provident Fund amount, Gratuity amount, Commutation of Pension amount and Leave Salary amount to the petitioner at the rate of 6% per annum, for the period from (31.07.2023) the date of retirement to till the date of



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actual disbursement within a time frame.

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Prayer in W.P.No.1662 of 2026:

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest on the belated payment of terminal benefits such as Provident Fund amount, Gratuity amount, Commutation of Pension amount and Leave Salary amount to the petitioner at the rate of 6% per annum for the period from (31.07.2024) the date of retirement to till the date of actual disbursement within a time frame.

COMMON ORDER

By consent, the writ petitions are taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.These writ petitions have been filed seeking issuance of Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest to the petitioners for the belated payment of retirement benefits, within a specified time.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted



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that the petitioner who had joined the services of the respondent Corporation, had retired from service on 31.07.2023 and 31.07.2024 respectively, however, the terminal benefits have been settled only on 25.08.2025 and 02.12.2025 respectively. Therefore, the petitioners claimed 6% interest on the belated payment of terminal benefits and made representation to the respondents to pay interest for the belated payment of terminal benefits, however, there is no response.

4.In view of the limited request made by the petitioner with regard to interest on the belated payment of terminal benefits, this Court directs the respondents to pay interest @ 6% for the belated payment of terminal benefits from the date of retirement till the date of actual disbursement of terminal benefits of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.Accordingly, these writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.
