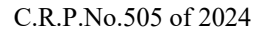

Infact, the Trial Court permitted the respondent to have interaction with the child only one day that too in the Court premises. In such circumstances, I do not find any serious error in the impugned order passed by the Subordinate Judge, Chidambaram in I.A.No.54 of 2023 in H.M.O.P.No.9 of 2022 dated 11.09.2023.
