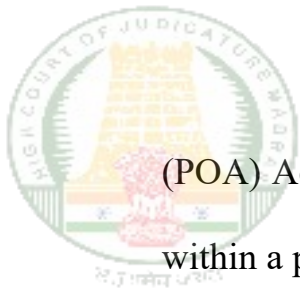

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the learned District and Sessions Judge (Spl. Judge for SC/ST Act) at Tirupattur to consider the petitioners' bail petition(s) on the same day on their surrender before the Court in connection with the case in Crime No.351 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent police.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned District and Sessions Judge (Spl. Judge for SC/ST Act) at Tirupattur to consider the petitioners' bail application(s), preferably on the same day of their surrender, in connection with Crime No.351 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent Police and to pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under Section 15-A of the SC/ST



(POA) Act, 1989. The petitioners shall surrender before the jurisdictional Court within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

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3. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
