ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
10.12.2025 for the alleged offence **under Sections 126(2), 296(b),311,**
351(3) of BNS in Crime No.1114 of 2025 on the file of the respondent
police, seeks bail.



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2. The case of prosecution is that the petitioner waylaid the defacto complainant at knife point and robbed a sum of Rs.1,150/- from him. Hence, this case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and was in judicial custody since **10.12.2025**. He further submitted that even though the petitioner is having some previous cases all the cases is of the year 2016 and 2017. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court and ready to cooperate with the investigation. Hence, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that there are four previous case pending against the petitioner the investigation in this case is almost completed. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. I have heard the learned counsel on either side and also perused the materials available on record.



6.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and also taking note of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) and taking note of the nature of offence and investigation in this case is almost completed and considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and even though the petitioner is having some previous cases all the cases is of the year 2016 and 2017, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** with **two sureties each**, for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Madhavaram** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall appear before the **District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Madhavaram** daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of **three weeks and thereafter as and when required for**



interrogation by the respondent police.

[c] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**

[d] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
