ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 28.11.2021.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, a representation was filed by the petitioner to stop the illegal functioning of the Crushers and Hollow Block manufacturing Unit of the 7 and 8th respondents situated at No.67, Pillaiyar Kovil Street, C.V.M Annamalaipuram, Manavur, Tiruvallur District.
