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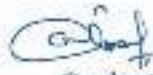
6. The following settlement has been arrived at between the Parties herein.

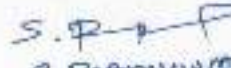

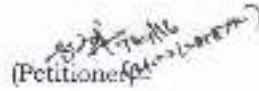
