ORDER

2. The limited relief that the petitioners are seeking before this Court is for an early disposal of the petitioners' representation/appeal, dated 04.11.2025, pending on the file of the 3rd respondent.

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3. Mr.C.Jayaprakash, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 to 4 and Mr.C.Gowthamaraj, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the 5th respondent.

4. No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the petitioners' representation/appeal is directed to be disposed of by the 3rd respondent on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the objections of the 5th respondent and any other third party, whom the 3rd respondent deems it fit to enquire, and by adhering to the principles of natural justice, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court. This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioners' representation/appeal.

5. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the 3rd respondent to pass final orders, on merits and in accordance with law, on the petitioners' representation/appeal, dated 04.11.2025, after hearing the objections of the 5th respondent or any other third party, whom the 3rd respondent deems it fit to enquire, and by adhering to the principles of

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natural justice, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
