ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.01.2026, for the offences punishable under Sections 137(2), 115(2), 118(1), 127(2), 140(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS, in Crime No.2 of 2026, registered on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.



6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the period of incarceration undergone by the Petitioner and the co-accused was granted bail by this Court in Crl.OP.No.1698 of 2026 dated 27.01.2026, and there is no previous case pending against the petitioner, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner herein with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate-I, Krishnagiri and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the

learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
