Swaminathan, learned counsel appearing for the parties that the 1st appellant has already settled the property by a registered settlement deed in favour of the 2nd appellant and in view of the same, the 1st appellant has no subsisting interest in the suit property and his signature is not required in the Joint Memorandum of Compromise. As such, the compromise memo signed by the 2nd appellant and the respondent would be sufficient. Hence, the Registry may proceed to draft the final decree and issue the same on or before 30.06.2026. The appellants shall pay the applicable non-judicial stamp duty/Court fees on or before 15.06.2026.
