ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct Respondents to disburse the Arrears of Surrender Leave Salary for the year of 2009-2012 and 2016-2019 and 12(3) wage Settlement Arrears with effect from 01.01.2023 to the petitioner.

2. With the consent of the learned counsel appearing on either side, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the admission stage.

3. It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner, who had joined the services of the respondent Corporation, had retired from service in the year 2022, however, the terminal benefits have been settled belatedly. Therefore, the petitioner claimed interest on the belated payment of terminal benefits and he has also made representation on 22.12.2025 to pay interest for the belated payment of terminal benefits and unsettled benefits which has not been evoked any response so far. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Heard the learned counsels appearing on either side and perused the materials available on record.

5. In view of the limited request made by the petitioner with regard to interest on the belated payment of terminal benefits, this Court directs the



respondent to pay interest @ 6% for the belated payment of terminal benefits from the date of retirement till the date of actual disbursal of terminal benefits of the petitioner and settle the all other eligible benefits, if not settled already, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order taking into account the bank rate of interest on deposits.

6. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
