ORDER

time stipulated by this Court.

Recording the submissions made by the learned learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Court directs the petitioner to appear before the 3rd respondent on the date fixed and furnish all particulars as required under the aforesaid circular issued by the Director General of Police. On receipt of such particulars, the 3rd respondent shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four (4) weeks thereafter.
