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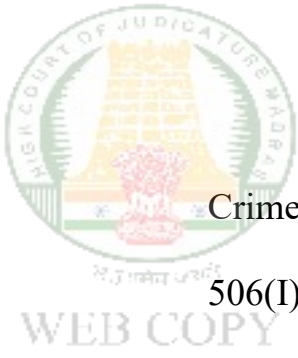

When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the 1st respondent, on instructions, submitted that pursuant to the order dated 03.08.2021 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate V, Coimbatore, in Crl.M.P.No.10053 of 2021, directing the 1st respondent police to conduct enquiry on the petitioner's complaint and register an FIR and proceed in accordance with law, if any cognizable offence is made out, the 1st respondent-police have conducted investigation/enquiry on the petitioner's complaint and subsequently, registered an FIR in



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Crime No.108 of 2026 for the offences under Sections 420, 406, 120B, 506(I) and 34 of IPC as against the respondents 2 to 5 herein, on 16.02.2026 ie., yesterday and that the investigation in this case is under progress and the 1st respondent-police will be able to complete the investigation and file a final report as expeditiously as possible.
